

AUCTION RULES 2022

To ensure security of items offered for auction, it is requested that participants please observe the following rules: -

- If you wish to bid, please register at the registration desk and exchange your registration form for a Registration Number Card. **Bids will not be accepted without a bidding number.**
- Registration fee for buyers and sellers is \$5.
- If you want to inspect an item before bidding, ask a steward to bring it to you.
- If you wish a passed-in item to be re-auctioned, a request should be made to one of the auctioneer's assistants.
- No goods are to be removed from the auction building without proof of ownership. This is achieved by presenting to the Security Stewards an invoice which has been stamped PAID. This also applies to items purchased at the fixed price table, and unsold items..
- When you have finished bidding for items, please return your Registration Number Card to the Treasurer's Table. An invoice will be prepared and payment recorded.
- We regret that we are unable to provide interim summaries of your payments or receipts during the course of the auction.
- Auction fees are 10% of selling price. This will be paid by the vendor and deducted from the sales price.
- Payments to TMAC may be made by cash, or EFTPOS. We cannot accept cheques or credit cards.
- Payments by TMAC will be by electronic funds transfer to your nominated account. We can no longer provide cheques.
- Tauranga Model Aircraft Club (Inc.) accepts no responsibility what-so-ever for any losses, suitability or condition of any items offered for auction or for sale.
- All items purchased are at the buyer's risk and any disputes must be resolved between the buyer and seller.
- Items uncollected within 3 days following the auction become the property of TMAC.
- The gold coin table is CASH ONLY. If you need some coins, you can use EFTPOS at the cashiers table to make a cash withdrawal.
